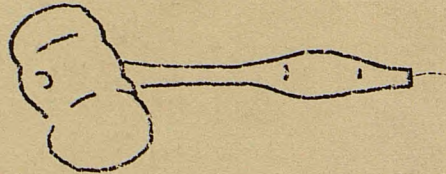
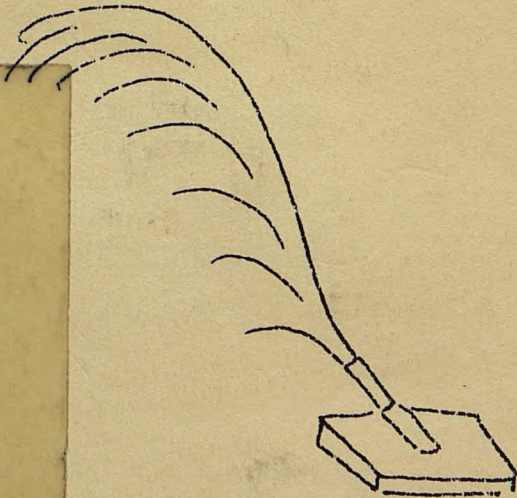

JUNE TERM.. 1808

The sheriff called the following jurors: Aaron Rutgers, Foreman.. William J. Mr. Wherry had in his custody and care a keg of powder, he then was assaulted and force of arms by Francois in the line of duty of the sheriff..the defendant pleads not guilty. The jury is now called: David Darst, John Ferry, Thomas Smith, Thomas Lucby, John Smith, David Miracle, John Manlee/Maniee??, Jesse Morrison, Warren Gilbert, Daniel Kiethley, George Price and James Jones..The jury finds him guilty..two declining to vote.

Boone, James Journey, William O'Bannon, Martin Wood, Joseph Dupline, Francois Ricar, George Price and Warner Gilbert. The jury finds him guilty.

The lands were purchased by Samuel Hammond and Edward Hempstead, two tracts for Hammond 103.00..and Hempstead the other.
- 21 James Jones and wife vs. Robert Baldrige..trespass and assult and battery..judgement for plaintiff.
- 22 Samuel Griffith vs. William Morrison..Slander..for plaintiff..
- 23 Dennis Julien vs. Marie Hebert.
- 24 Jacques Clemorgan vs. Edward Chandler..judgement for def'd.
- 25 Henry Hight presented his accounts of \$33.00 for services.
- 26 Baptiste Pugal was granted license to keep public house in the village of Portage des Sioux at his house.
- 27 August Chouteau and Pascal Cerre'..the executors of Gabriel Cerre' dec'd. vs. Thomas Lusby.. Def'd to receive judgemant for their false clamor.
- 28 Claiborne Rhodes granted license to keep ferry at his landing on the Cuivre near Mc Laughlins.
- 29 Taxes held by the sheriff for the years 1807..\$175.27.. The legislature presented it's definition of the duties of the office of sheriff.
- 30 Legislature also created the office of Territorial Treasurer.
- 31 The sheriff presented the lands sold list..One lot in the common

31 field of the village of Saint Charles 40 arpens bounded by the lands of Baptiste Daniels and Pierre Daniels, these were purchased by Basil Froulse(?), the lots were the property of John F. Gates..the property of Jacque Tecto(?) were purchased by Francois Duquette..also a house and lot on Main Street the property adjoining that of Francois Teabeau (labeau??) this being purchased by Edward Hempstead.
